Spring Clean: Great time to start

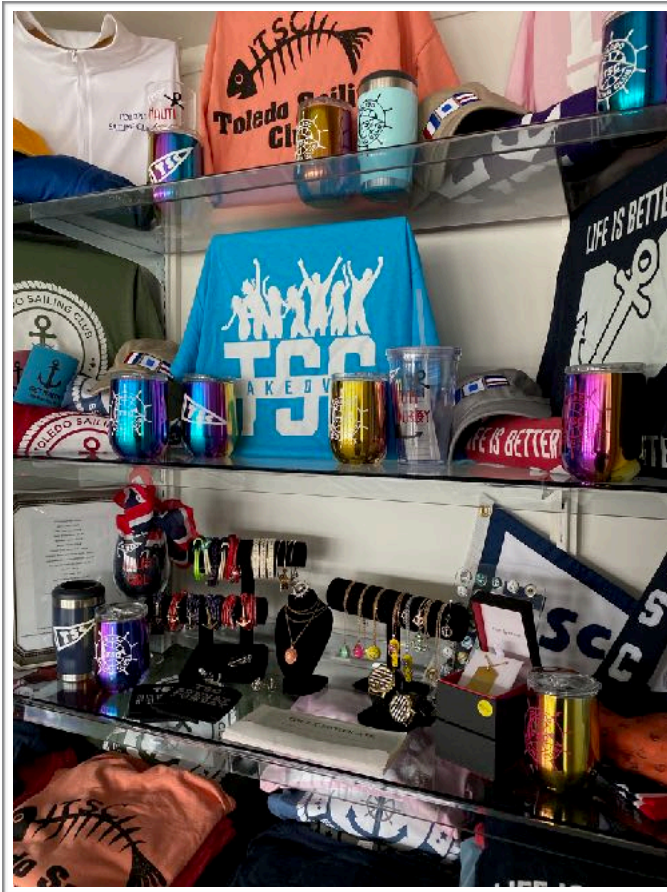

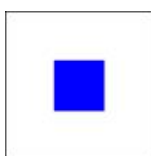
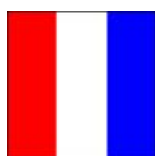
