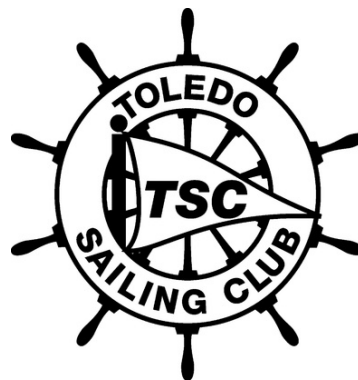

Ingredients:

- Ice cubes
- 1 fluid ounce Irish whiskey (such as Jameson)
- ½ fluid ounce Irish cream liqueur (such as Baileys)
- 1 splash creme de menthe liqueur

Instructions:

Fill a cocktail shaker with ice. Pour in Irish whiskey, Irish cream liqueur, and creme de menthe. Cover and shake until the outside of shaker has frosted. Strain into a shot glass.

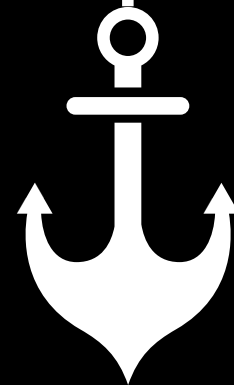

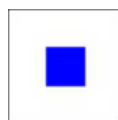
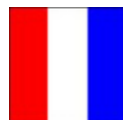
