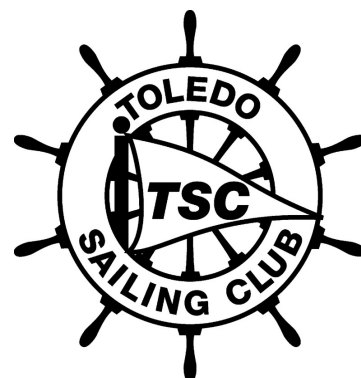

FLEET CAPTAIN RYAN MILLER

Happy June everyone!

Many thanks to all who put in hours, especially those who took the initiative to lead the efforts to get our marina open!

I assume by the time you're reading this, TSC/BVYC/MRYC/TYC had a great time at our annual Opening of the Port ceremony down at TYC & BVYC. A lot of planning & coordination goes into that weekend, and I hope many of you chose to enjoy the weekend of events. For those wanting to see the northern clubs' version of the ceremonies, I encourage you to attend the Opening of the Island the weekend of June 10-12, with our Bridge participating in their ceremony on Saturday, June 11 at Ford Yacht Club.

Don't forget we have scheduled a complimentary Vessel Safety Check on Saturday, June 4, from 10:00 – Noon. A member of the USCGA will be at TSC during that time to provide the annual sticker for those boats that check all the boxes. Given the limited time they are here, I encourage you all to contact me if you are interested in getting your boat inspected & your dock number. I will ask that they go to those boats first, with day-of notification being done with whatever time remains.

I thought this might be a good time to throw some safety reminders out that can help protect us all to ensure a safe and fun summer:

1. Check your fire extinguishers and flares to make sure they are properly charged and not expired. Don't forget the new regulations that went into effect on April 20.
2. Be sure to inspect your electrical connections and systems to ensure everything is tight and corrosion-free. I imagine the dock committee will be coming around to check for stray current in the water now that the docks are officially opened and boats start filling the marina. Notifying them to come down and check around your boat can help keep our marina safe. **Remember: No one should get into the water in any marina.**
3. Consider installing or checking a number of safety detection devices that can save your boat, or more importantly you! Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors in the sleeping areas have been written about frequently and are always a good idea. A couple others mentioned recently are high-bilge-water and gasoline vapor detectors down in the engine compartment.
4. If you're a member of Boat US, download the Boat US app on your phone to get instant access to your services, weather forecasts/advisories, and request a tow.
5. Another useful app is from the US Coast Guard. Safety equipment checklists, requesting a Safety Check, filing a float plan, brushing up on the "Rules of the Road", reporting a hazard, etc. You can also populate a profile with your boat and contact information. In case of an emergency there is a one touch call button that shares your location and information.
6. I'm still trying to get information about a "Suddenly in Command" class, but encourage you to

do a search on your own to get some tips. Most times we're in a hurry to get moving, excited to the trip started, or just don't think anything will happen. Taking a few minutes to make sure people know where life jackets, fire extinguishers, throwables, etc. are at could prove life saving.

I didn't start out to draft a serious article, but hopefully noting a few of these steps can keep us all safe!

Finally, I hope to see many of you attend our Homecoming, June 17-19! For those newer members that haven't been here, it is a great time and talked about the rest of the summer (especially the \$1.98 dance)! Please volunteer to help! It takes a major effort to pull off this weekend, and many hands make light work. I also encourage you to come down to your club and welcome our guests from other clubs from all over the lake. Ours is one of the first of homecomings/regattas, and a great way to meet fellow boaters!

CONSTITUTION / BYLAW

PROPOSED CHANGE NOTIFICATION

Addition to Article IV of the Constitution:

Section 5 - Active and provisional members in good standing may transfer their memberships to their spousal member by requesting in writing to the board of directors. The board of Directors will confirm their good standing and authorize this transfer without further action.

Existing:

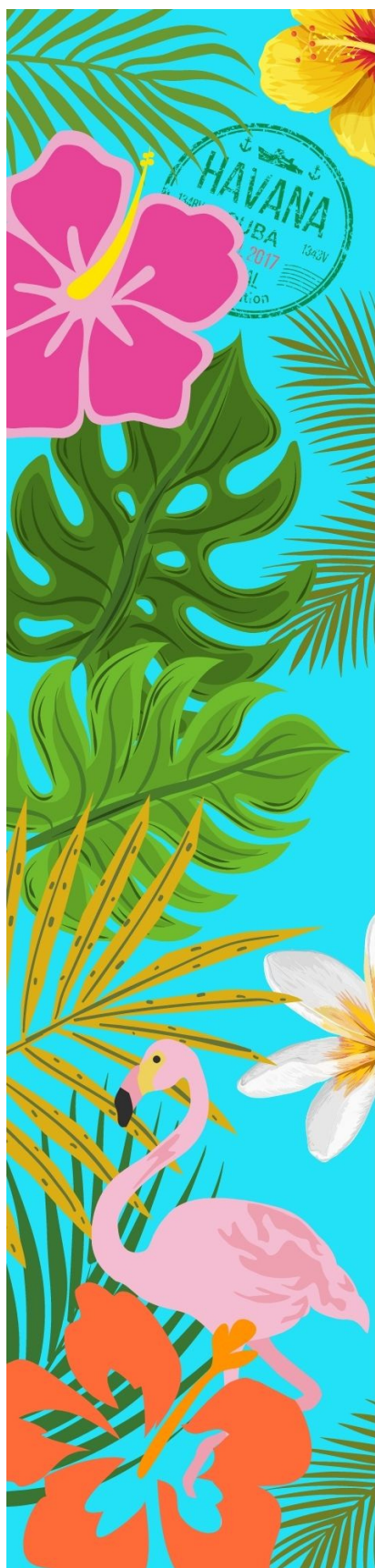
Article VI:

Section 6 - The Treasurer shall be responsible for all funds deposited by the Financial Secretary. All disbursements must be approved for payment by a majority of active members present at the regular meeting, at which a quorum is present; provided, however, that regular monthly bills shall Page 6 to 11 Rev. Feb 19, 2020 ARTICLE VI - DUTIES OF OFFICERS (cont.) be paid when due. **All bills authorized for payment shall be paid by check signed by the Treasurer and Commodore.**

The Treasurer shall keep detailed reports of all disbursements and shall make them available to the Auditing Committee on request. The Treasurer shall be responsible for preparing and maintaining an annual budget for the club. Following Board of Directors approval of the proposed budget, it shall be submitted to the full membership for approval. At the end of his term, or renewal thereof, he shall turn over to his successor of the Club all monies, books, and other property of the Club in his possession.

Proposed:

All bills authorized for payment that are paid by check will be signed by the Treasurer and Financial Secretary. Treasurer and Financial Secretary shall be signors on all club accounts.

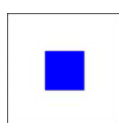
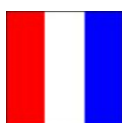

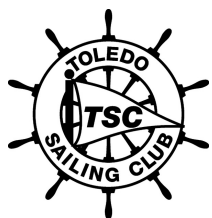
