

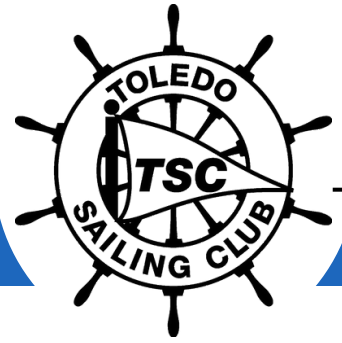

Subject: Toledo Sailing Club By-Laws Proposed Change

Reason: To encourage Provisional members to complete work hours

Current:

ARTICLE 3 – ELECTION TO MEMBERSHIP

2. Each Provisional member shall be required to work a total of twenty-five (25) hours for the Club during the twelve (12) month period immediately following his election to Provisional membership. Work hours requirement for a Provisional member for the year of his or her election to membership shall be prorated through October 31 of that year at the rate of 2.0 hours per full calendar month. (i.e. A Provisional member voted into Active membership in June, would be required to work 8 hours prior to October 31. A Provisional member voted into Active membership in August, would be required to work 4 hours prior to October 31.)

Proposed (addition is bold and italicized):

ARTICLE 3 – ELECTION TO MEMBERSHIP

2. Each Provisional member shall be required to work a total of twenty-five (25) hours for the Club during the twelve (12) month period immediately following his election to Provisional membership. ***Each Provisional member who fails to fulfill this obligation will be billed at the rate of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each deficient hour and must be paid prior to consideration into Active membership.*** Work hours requirement for a Provisional member for the year of his or her election to membership shall be prorated through October 31 of that year at the rate of 2.0 hours per full calendar month. (i.e. A Provisional member voted into Active membership in June, would be required to work 8 hours prior to October 31. A Provisional member voted into Active membership in August, would be required to work 4 hours prior to October 31.)

Shamrock Shake

Ingredients

3 large scoops vanilla ice cream (about 1/4 c. each)
1/4 c. heavy cream
1/2 tsp. peppermint extract
6 drops green food coloring
Whipped cream, for topping
Maraschino cherry, for topping

Directions

Step 1

In a blender, mix vanilla ice cream, heavy cream, peppermint extract, and food coloring until completely smooth, then pour into a glass.

Step 2

Top with whipped cream and a cherry before serving.



Corned Beef Sandwich

Ingredients

4 tbsp. butter, softened
8 slices rye bread
1/4 c. mustard
1/4 c. relish
1/2 lb. deli corned beef
1/2 c. sauerkraut

Directions

Step 1

Butter one side of each slice of rye bread. On 4 of the unbuttered sides, spread a layer of mustard and relish. Top with corned beef and sauerkraut. Top with remaining slices of bread, buttered side up.

Step 2

Heat a medium skillet over medium heat and place sandwich in skillet. Cook until toasted, 3 minutes per side.

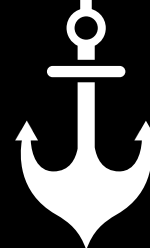

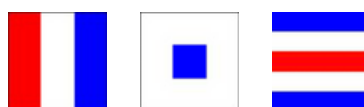
