

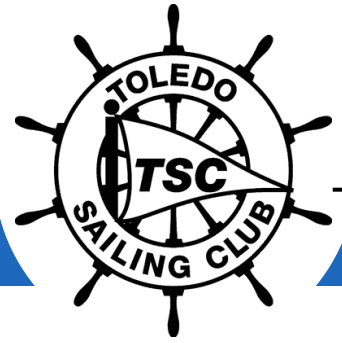

Reason: Recommendation by our insurance carrier


### Existing Language

Toledo Sailing Club By-Laws Article 6, Section A, Item 7

All members when paying for dockage for the current year will show proof of liability insurance of a minimum of \$100,000 on the craft. Boats must be owned or leased by the member or spouse or in the case of partnership, other than spouse, all partners must be members of the Club.

### Proposed Language

All members when paying for dockage for the current year will show proof of liability insurance of a minimum of \$300,000 on the craft. Boats must be owned or leased by the member or spouse or in the case of partnership, other than spouse, all partners must be members of the Club.

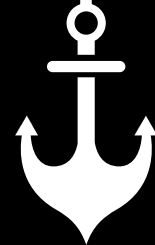

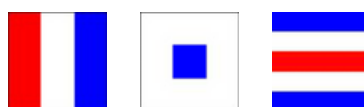
