Hello Friends!

I hope all is well with you, and you are getting opportunities to enjoy the summer sunshine! For the summer months, we have some new products. Be sure to check them out when you are at the club enjoying the deck on a hot summer day.

Hoop Tea - "Summer in a Jar" - Hoop Tea is a spiked iced tea that is a low-calorie, low-carb alcoholic beverage. It is made with real tea leaves and is infused with natural flavors. I'm told it is a bit sweeter than Twisted Tea and

described as more like a Sweet Tea with a kick.

Truly - Red White and Tru - Hard seltzer - 4 limited flavors - Cherry Pop, Blue Razz, Peach Burst, and Lemon Ice. Each drink in the lineup has only 100 calories, 1 gram of sugar, and 2 grams of carbohydrates, making it a guilt-free indulgence. Plus, they're gluten-free.

You can find the candy selection in the small cooler where the cans of pop are stored.

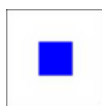
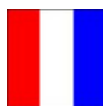
